Overview

Does Serbia have a solar project?

The contract is the latest in a line of solar projects backed by Serbia's Ministry of Mining and Energy this year, which includes plans for a 1 GW solar panel factory and another 500 MW of solar. Figures from the International Renewable Energy Agency state Serbia had deployed a total 137 MW of solar by the end of last year.

Why should Serbia invest in solar power plants?

Located throughout the country, these solar power plants will help Serbia improve energy security, avoid expensive energy imports, and achieve electricity independence at an affordable price. The modernization of the EPS and renewing Serbia's Energy Generation Portfolio will have a lasting impact on communities throughout Serbia.

Who owns the large-scale solar and battery energy storage project?

Delivering the utmost flexibility to the Serbian government, the Large-Scale Solar and Battery Energy Storage Project being developed by UGT Renewables will be owned and operated by Electric Power Industry of Serbia (EPS) once completed.

Is solar a good option for Serbia?

A statement published on the Serbian government's website says solar is the most optimal solution to quickly reach large capacities from green sources, without burdening and endangering the stability of the transmission network. Serbia currently gets more than 60% of its electricity from fossil fuels.
