Announced by Governor Kathy Hochul on July 28, 2025, this Request for Proposals (RFP) invites participants to compete for 15- to 25-year contracts supported by the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority's (NYSERDA's) market-based Index Storage Credit (ISC) incentive.

Governor Kathy Hochul today announced the launch of New York's first Bulk Energy Storage Request for Proposals (RFP), intended to procure one gigawatt (GW) of bulk energy storage as part of New York's 6 GW Energy Storage Roadmap. Adding bulk energy storage to New York's grid will lower costs.

NYSEG has developed a request for proposal (RFP) to procure a minimum of 10 MW of energy storage projects to be in service by December 31, 2030. This initiative will help meet energy storage goals and complement the growing use of intermittent technologies on the transmission and distribution.

Con Edison and Orange & Rockland are seeking bids for scheduling and dispatch rights for distribution and transmission connected energy storage systems that will achieve commercial operation by end of 2030. Please review all requirements and provisions of the Request for Proposal and appendices.

The 2024 UDR Request for Proposal (UDR4) was released December 16, 2024. The program grants scheduling and dispatch rights to Con Edison for new front-of-the-meter energy storage resources in exchange for enhanced revenue certainty. Must be interconnected in the CECONY and O&R service territory.

On May 13, 2025, the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority ("NYSERDA") released a draft Index Storage Credit Request for Proposals (ISCRFP25-1) for bulk energy storage projects (the "Draft RFP"). ISCRFP25-1 is the first of three solicitations planned by NYSEERDA in service of.

What is bulk energy storage & how can it help New York?

The PSC's prior 2024 Order Establishing Updated Energy Storage Goals and Deployment Policy 4 required NYSERDA to issue its first competitive solicitation for bulk storage through a request for proposals (RFP) by June 30, 2025.
