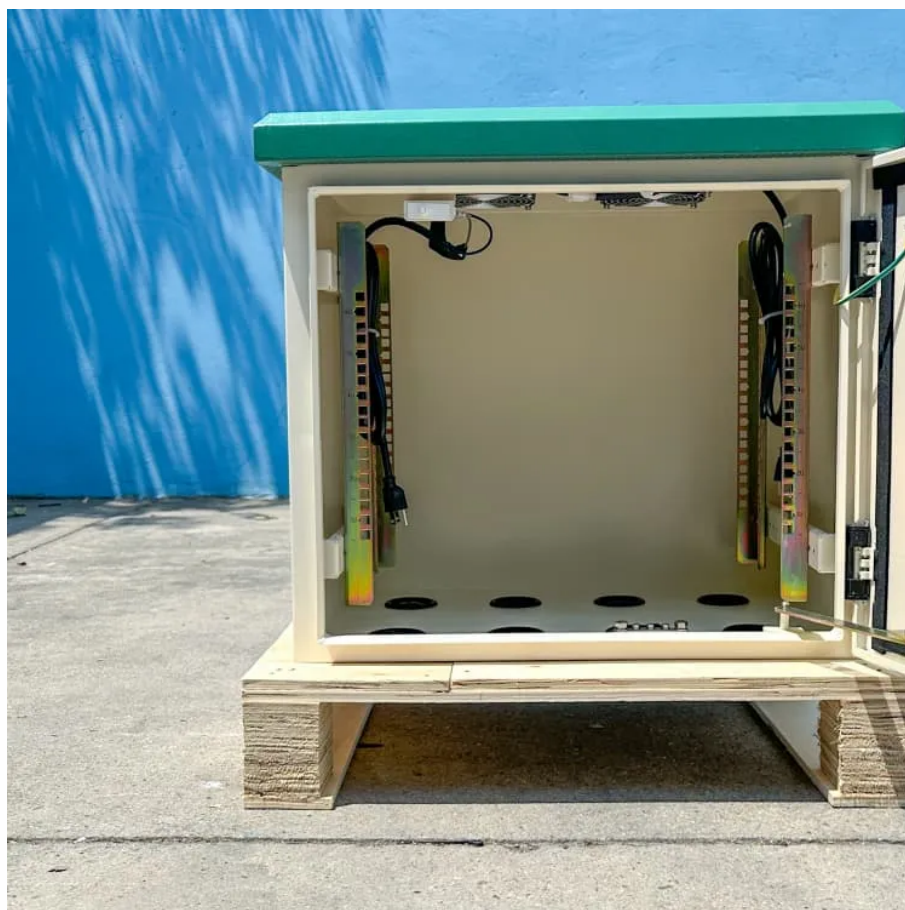

Overview

Is Slovakia dependent on energy imports?

Thus, Slovakia is a country critically dependent on energy imports. Primary energy consumption is dominated by nuclear and renewables – 38.9%, followed by oil – 24.6%, gas – 20.4%, and coal – 13.4%. Figure 2. The production and consumption of fossil fuels in Slovakia (coal – left, gas – in the center, oil – right).

How much electricity does Slovakia produce?

At the same time, consumption of oil and gas has exceeded domestic production many times. Slovakia has been generating 25 to 29 TWh of electricity over the past 10 years, of which approximately 60% is provided by nuclear power. The share of electricity from renewable sources, excluding hydropower, has been growing, but remains modest.

Is biomass a viable energy source in Slovakia?

Biomass currently dominates electricity generation from renewables, followed by biogas, solar, and hydropower. Despite its high potential, wind energy remains largely untapped in Slovakia due to its perceived instability and regulatory hurdles.

What are Slovak Republic's energy policies?

Slovak Republic's recent energy policies have made significant progress. Along with its neighbours and with support from the European Union, the country has strengthened cross-border connections for electricity, natural gas and oil, improving its ene

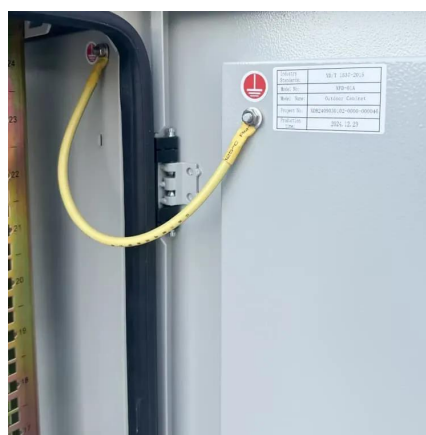

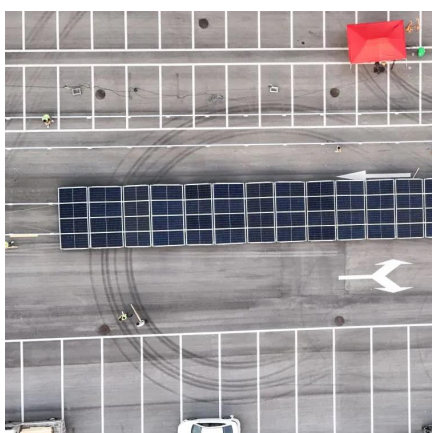
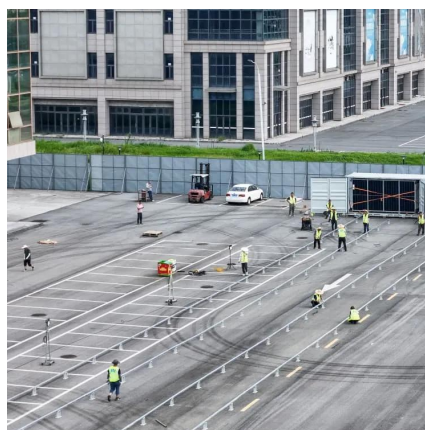
